Thank you for your consideration to sponsor High School Rodeo. Idaho High School Rodeo Association is a non-profit association and is a member of the National High School Rodeo Association. Idaho is then divided into districts. District 6 includes all of the schools on the south side of the river from Castleford to Raft River. We have one of the largest districts with approximately 85 members in grades 9-12. The purpose of high school rodeo is to develop sportsmanship, horsemanship and the character of youth through the sport of rodeo and to encourage students to continue in school and to improve his/her education.

Contestants accumulate points throughout the season. The top six in each event will qualify to go on to the State competition held in June. The top four qualifiers at State will then go on to compete at the National competition in July.

Over the years, we have been able to award belt buckles, or custom bit or spur certificates to all qualifiers, saddles to the All-around recipients and over \$6,000 in scholarships to graduating seniors. You may help in any or all of the following ways—
